He is working internationally as consultant for project evaluation for governmental agencies such as the Austrian Science Fund (FWF), the Deutsche Forschungsgemeinschaft (DFG), Swiss National Foundation, and the National Centre of Science and Technology Evaluation of the Republic of Kazakhstan.
